
Our next meeting is the "2019 Spring Fair" 6th September 2019 from 11:30am to 3:00pm Admission: \$5 for "day members".




Terlenka also known as Texture of Burlington is a polyester fabric known for being used in the manufacture of trousers and made in the Netherlands.




It is a supple fabric that is comfortable to wear as trousers, jackets, suits, dresses or skirts.

In addition this fabric is extremely suitable for decorative articles such as tablecloths, curtains, theatre fabric, etc.





Anne ORR—Embroidery

In WINTER 1983, the Chicago Playing Card Collectors Inc. (CPCC) published an information sheet as transcribed below:

ANNE ORR

Between the years 1910 and 1945, international authority, author, editor, designer, Mrs Anne Champe ORR created nearly 100 books for designs for needleworkers. These books combined artistic excellence and a thorough understanding of a needleworker's needs and goals. As needlework editor of "Good Housekeeping" magazine her designs became part of the décor of thousands of American homes. Even today [1983] many years after her death, the magazine still receives correspondence regarding her designs.

Several example of her artistic talent have been used as back designs for playing cards. Barbara Lunaburg has identified many of these cards and they will be incorporated in a future supplement to the Treasures list. [A 5 page Supplement issued September 1983].
